2. <u>Entry Fee</u>: \$1,500.00 per boat which includes four registered anglers – All entry fees will go directly to <u>Twin Palms Center for the Disabled</u>. *No refunds will be given for entry fee.* Entry fee deadline is May 1st, 2019, after May 1st, 2019, the entry fee is \$1,750.00. Entry will include dinner tickets and drink tickets for both Friday night and Saturday night for the four registered anglers; however, six anglers are permitted to fish and will be responsible for their meal and drink tickets available upon request. Extra meal and drink ticket will be available to purchase for guests in attendance.

3. <u>Boat Slips</u>: Anyone requiring a boat slip is recommended to contact Tournament Chairperson Edgar Benes, 561-866-6075 to check on availability at the Royal Palm Yacht & Country Club.

4. Licenses: All anglers must possess necessary valid fishing licenses.

5. <u>Tournament Hours</u>: Saturday – Lines in at 7:00am, Lines out at 3:30pm. Weigh in will be held at the Marina at the Royal Palm Yacht & Country Club between 3:00pm and 5:30pm. Boundaries are between Jupiter Inlet to the North and Port Everglades to the South. Committee boat will monitor VHF channel 73.

6. **Equipment** – All fish must be caught on rod and reel. The angler must fight and bring the fish to the boat unaided by any other person. Kites may be used, electric reels permitted for kites only. IGFA rules. No professional anglers allowed. Six line maximum.

7. <u>**Registration**</u> – All anglers on board must be registered. Up to six anglers may be registered.

8. <u>Eligible Fun Fish</u> – Tuna, Wahoo, Kingfish, Cobia and Dolphin. All fish weighed in must be fresh fish caught the day of the tournament. Anglers are encouraged to release fish not being entered. Minimum weight 10 lbs.

All billfish are eligible. 100 points will be issued for each billfish released which must be called in at the time of release. During the last 10 minutes of the tournament, all hook ups must be called in.

9. <u>Categories</u> – Top Boat – Two prizes, one for heaviest fish of eligible species of fun fish and most billfish releases.

12. <u>Consent</u> – By signing the entry form, the angler agrees to follow the tournament rules and that the tournament may use, without payment or restriction and photographs in which he or she appears for any purpose including but not limited to advertising, commercial or promotional material without compensation or restriction. All anglers are

required to sign their entry form as certification that they have read and agree to abide by all the rules and the above liability release. No entry will be accepted unsigned.

- > IGFA Rules Apply
- > No professional Anglers
- Circle hooks for all natural bait
- Fishing is based on the honor system
- Boundaries are between Jupiter Inlet to the North and Port Everglades to the South
- Fishing Hours: 7:00 am to 3:30 pm
- Weigh In opens at 3:00 until 5:30 pm
- Billfish releases must be called in to Committee boat
- > Last 10 minutes of tournament hook ups must be called in
- Monitor VHF channel 73
- > No Wire Lines or downriggers
- Six Lines ONLY
- No live bait chumming and all dead baits not used must not be thrown overboard.
- Kites may be used-electric reels may only be used for kites
- Billfish release is official when the mate or other angler touches the leader, or when the cork or leader touches the tip of the rod.
- Release Sheet with time of release and angler name must be signed and turned into the committee no later than 5:30pm on Saturday to be official.
- ALL Fun-fish being weighed must be a minimum of 10lbs.
